Monkeypox is a viral infection transmitted through close personal contact, such as kissing, sex, and other skin-to-skin contact. Many cases have been mild, but severe illness may occur. No matter what, stay updated & informed.

Rashes, bumps, or blisters.

These may appear anywhere on the body, including genitals. Symptoms may look similar to syphilis, herpes, or other common skin rashes. WHAT TO DO:
